## Cheyenne County Fair Board Meeting October 28 , 2024

The Cheyenne County Fair board held a meeting on Monday October 28, 2024 in the Cheyenne County Fairboard office at 10955 Hwy 30, Sidney, Nebraska. A notice of this meeting was published on 10/17/24, at the Sidney Sun Telegraph, the Cheyenne County website and Cheyenne County bulletin board. Copies of the agenda were transmitted to each Fairboard Member. Minutes are kept current and available to the public at the Cheyenne County Clerk's Office.

President Troy Kurz called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM, with the following fair board members present: Troy Kurz, Pat Finney, Kip Miller, Ryan Filsinger, Mark Roelle. Absent: Zach Oliverius, Tyler Bailey. Alternate members present: Shelby Roelle, Todd Thomas, Heather Shaw, Marvin Filsinger, JD Kogl. Guests present: Forrest Hershberger

President Kurz announced that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the fair board Office.

The Minutes of the Meeting on September 23, 2024 were reviewed. Motion was made by Miller, seconded by Finney to approve the Minutes as written. Roll Call: Aye: Miller, Filsinger, Roelle, Finney, Kurz. Naye: none.

**Treasurer's Report:** Miller reviewed the Treasurer's Report. Motion was made by Finney, seconded by Filsinger to accept the Treasurer's Report. Roll Call: Aye: Finney, Filsinger, Roelle, Kurz. Naye: none. Abstain: Miller.

**Order of Business:**

Miller spoke with NSTPA (Nebraska State Tractor Pullers Association) to gather more information on the truck and tractor pull. Suggested budget for this event is \$20,000 which includes \$1,850 for sled rental, \$598 for mileage, and a \$16,000 purse. If we decide to move forward with the truck and tractor pull on Thursday July 24, 2025, we need to make a decision

sooner than later, to secure a spot on their schedule. The Cheyenne County Fair would keep all gate receipts. If any class has no entries, we do not pay NSTPA for that class. Further details will be discussed at the next meeting.

Other Committees/Events: suggested budget for the Rubber Check Race is \$15,000 - \$20,000. Demolition Derby suggested budget is \$17,000 but could increase if the number of entries is over 20 cars.
