Electors desiring to vote against the question shall blacken the oval completely preceding the words "NO" (against the Program).</p> <p>Description of Local Option Sales Tax Proposal</p> <p>i. 50% of funding would go towards Street Improvements, estimated to generate an average of \$425,000 annually or \$4.25 million total over 10 years.</p> <p>ii. 25% of funding would go towards Aquatic Center infrastructure improvements such as paving of the parking lot and connecting the walking trail to the Swimming Pool, estimated to generate an average of about \$212,500 annually or \$2.12 million over 10 years.</p> <p>iii. 5% of funding would go towards infrastructure improvements to Hillside Golf Course such as paving the parking lot, estimated to generate an annual average of \$42,500 annually or \$425,000 over 10 years.</p> <p>iv. 10% of funding would go towards storm water mitigation projects working through an interlocal government agreement with the South Platte Natural Resources District to alleviate flood prone areas in Sidney, estimated to generate \$85,000 annually or \$850,000 over 10 years.</p> <p>v. 10% of funding would go towards Parks infrastructure improvements, such as parking pavement improvements, lighting, trails, or restroom facilities, estimated to generate \$85,000 annually or \$850,000 for 10 years.</p> <p>b.
